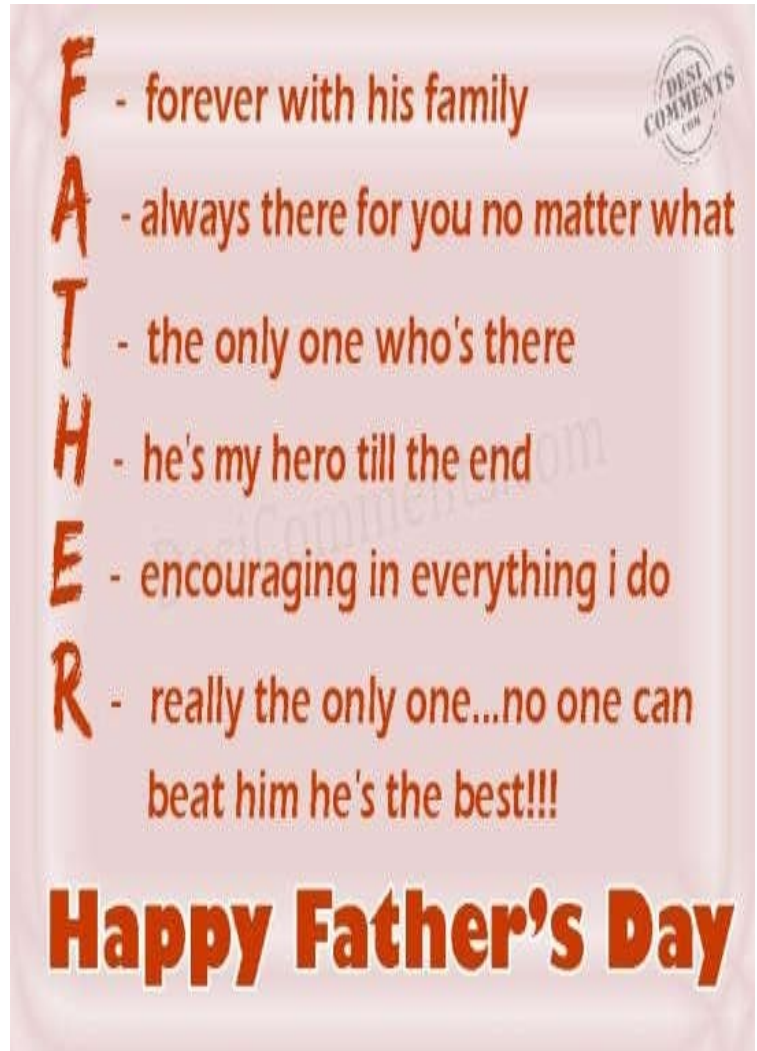

Does Your Group Make the List?

After group expenses for Rent, Prudent reserve, the GSR fund, Books, Coins and Coffee, it is suggested that the rest of the money should be divided for Tradition 7. This is per the AA pamphlet "Where Money & Spirituality Mix" (F-3) in the following way - 50% of the group's excess funds go to Central Office. G.S.O should receive 30%. The Area Committee should receive 10%, and the District receive 10%.

In Western Colorado there are 209 groups or meetings per week. In 2022, only 90 out of the 209 groups contributed to Central Office.

And for that we are **truly grateful** to all the groups who contributed to the Central Office. **Do you know where your Groups 7th Tradition is going?**

Colorado is Area 10 and our Central Office here in Western Colorado covers 7 districts. We are truly on the Front Lines when it comes to helping the still suffering alcoholic as well as family members looking for a solution. We manage a 24/7 hotline with over 39 volunteers as well as office volunteers.

It takes a fellowship to help keep us all sober.

To carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers.

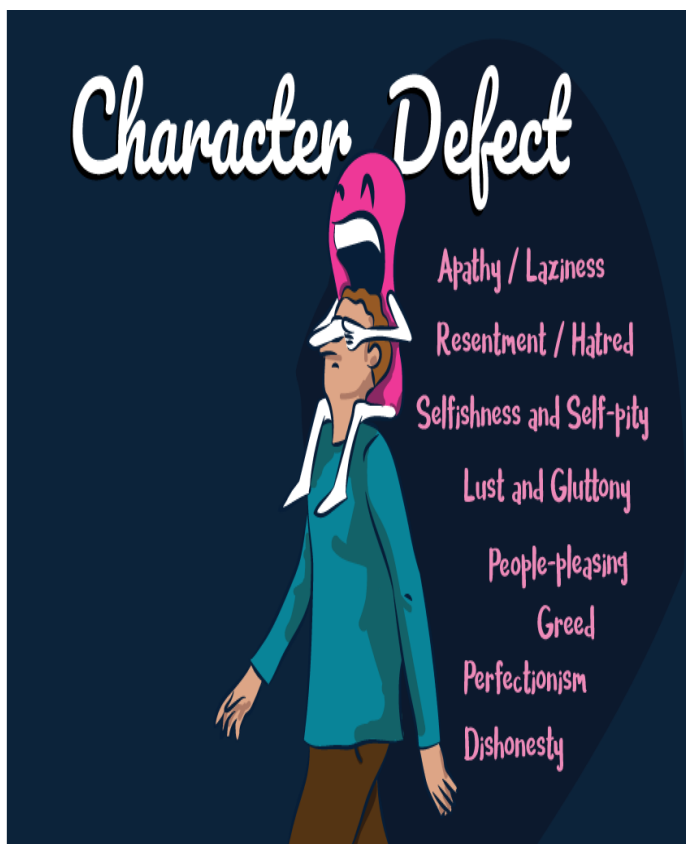


Step 6
