Page 2 Finance

Revenue and Expense:

Contributions year to date are \$4,309,644 which is 44% of the 2021 budget of \$9,725,000 and \$1,125,898 more than this time last year.

Continuation at this rate would receive \$10,667,059 for the year, exceeding last year's record for contributions.
