

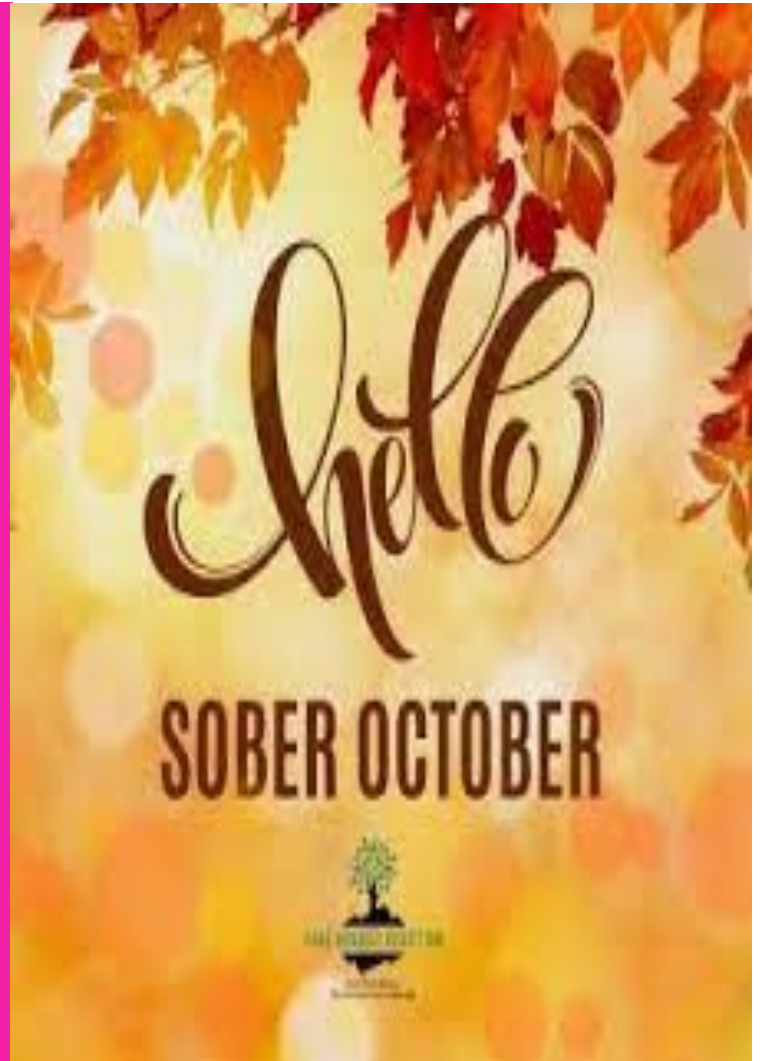

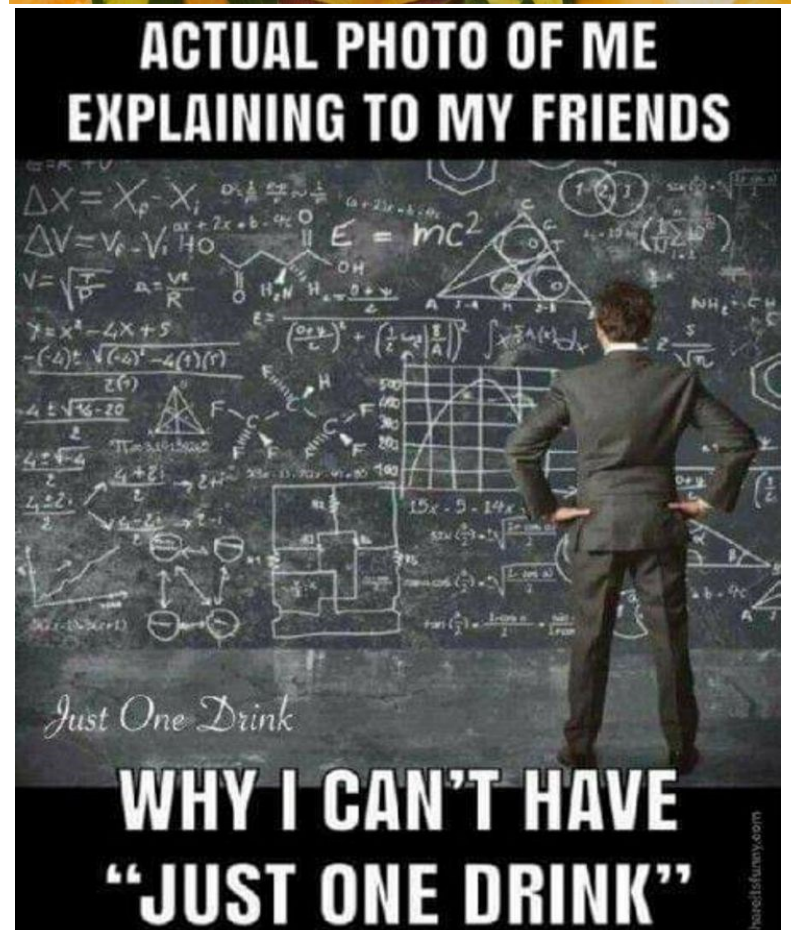

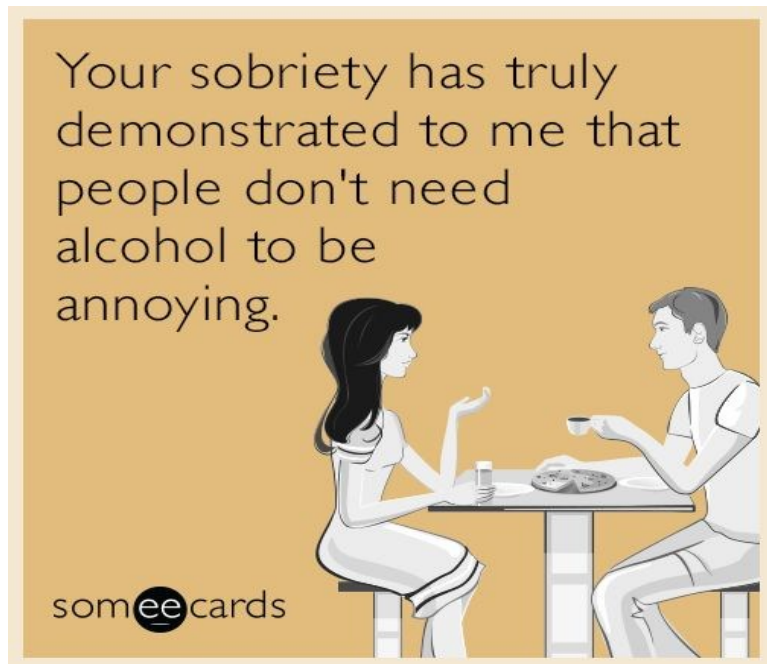


### Step 9
