Made a list of all person we harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all.

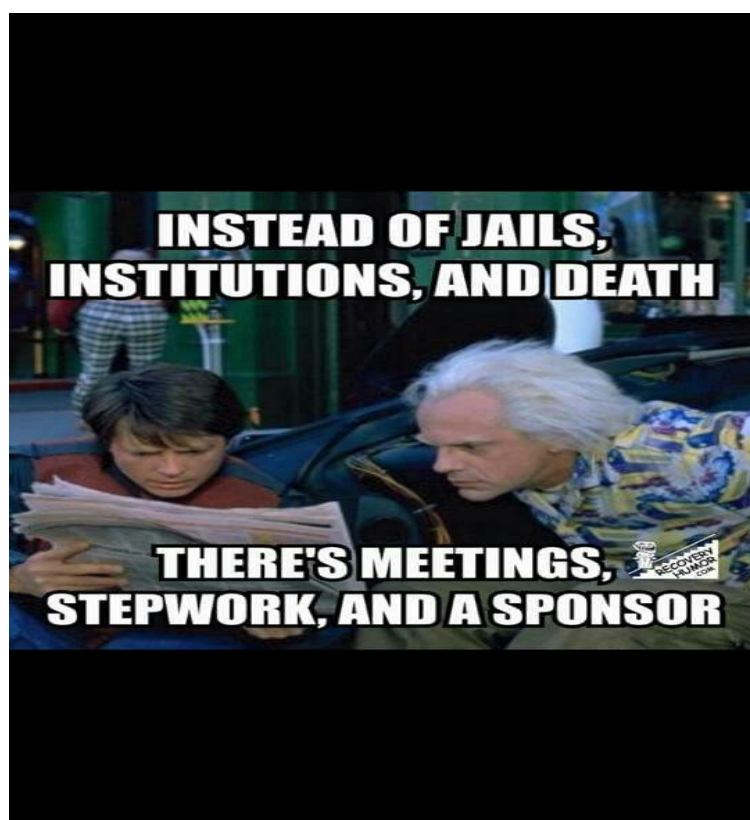
