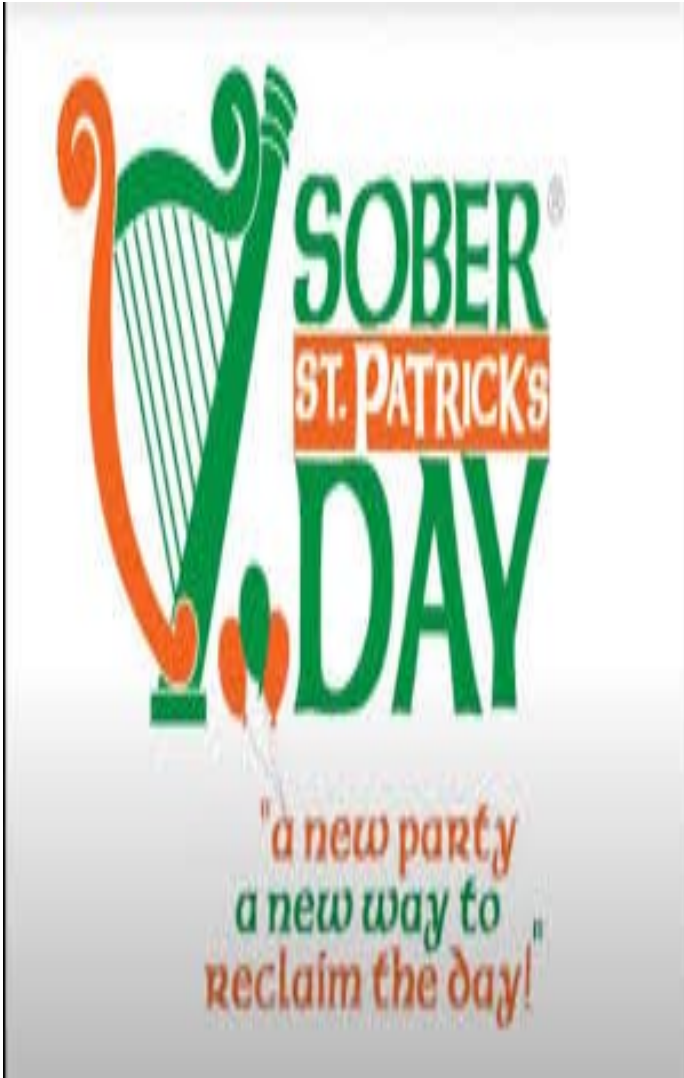

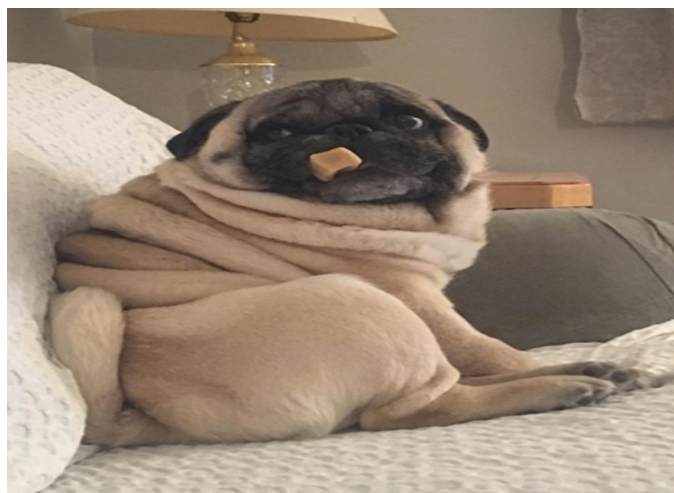


## Step 3
