Next, we are taking Intergroup on the Road to District 18 at the Pagosa Springs A.A. Clubhouse at noon on Saturday, October 13<sup>th</sup>. If you are down in that vicinity, we would love to see you there. Finally, in November, we will be having elections for the Intergroup Chairperson and Treasurer. Members-at-Large from Districts 1, 14, 18, and 20 will also be rotating. All these positions have twoyear terms.

Know the difference between the Central Office Hotline and the Confidential 12<sup>th</sup> Step Call List?? We need help with both. The Hotline: During Central Office non-business hours, phone calls are automatically forwarded to a hotline volunteer. This enables 24/7 365 day-a-year phone coverage for the alcoholic who still suffers. These volunteers are provided with general A.A. background information, meeting schedules, the confidential 12<sup>th</sup> Step list, and other information. The Confidential 12<sup>th</sup> Step Call List: A list of A.A. volunteers who have volunteered to go on 12<sup>th</sup> Step calls. When the Central Office or Hotline volunteers receive a request for a 12<sup>th</sup> Step call, they will contact a nearby volunteer from this list to do the 12<sup>th</sup> Step call. 12<sup>th</sup> Step volunteers are needed in all seven districts supported by the Central Office. Only the Central Office and Hotline Volunteer for either of these essential service jobs.

Remember, the Intergroup and Steering Committee exist to help groups in western Colorado in their common purpose of carrying the message to the alcoholic who still suffers. Our next meetings are at the Grand Junction Alano Club on Saturday, September 8<sup>th</sup>, 1:15 for the Steering Committee and 2:15 for the Intergroup. Stop in and get involved!


